What: Remove GRE requirements for admission of all GGS MS programs including ESS MS (shared with AOES). Reduce the required number of recommendation letters from three to two for all GGS MS programs.

Why: Usage of the GRE declined in admission decision and the GRE scores were not an indicator of student success. For reducing letters of recommendation, most MS students chose the non-thesis option. Letters are helpful only for research-oriented students.

The program also requires **two** GRE test scores, three letters of **recommendation** recommendation, transcripts of all college coursework, and a statement of interest in the degree.

The GRE requirement will be waived if the student holds a master's degree from an institution of higher education accredited by a Mason-recognized U.S. institutional accrediting agency or international equivalent. TOEFL scores are required for all foreignapplicants. Credit from courses taken at other departments and other universities may be applied to the program with prior approval.
