Justification

George Mason University Gateway (formerly INTO Mason) is launching a new suite of graduate programs in January 2027. These programs will be called Graduate International Direct (GID). Graduate International Direct programs will enroll international and multilingual students who have the same academic background as directly admitted domestic students to those specific graduate degree programs, and they will have the same English language proficiency, as measured by the established exams to include TOEFL, IELTS and Duolingo, as students did in the Graduate Accelerated INTO Mason Pathways in the past. The Graduate International Direct students will receive a direct entry I20 > F1 Visa, instead of the Pathway I20 received by (formerly) INTO Mason students. The GID will place a renewed focus on students with direct admissibility and will offer a one-semester study plan in which the students will enroll in coursework in English for Academic Purposes, (6 credits), Graduate Transition (3 credits) and one course in the desired degree program (approximately 3 credits).
